Oliver's Story



2016 – A Heartbreaking Year

Oliver was just 18 years old when he died in hospital. He had a rare and serious reaction to anti-psychotic medication.



Meet Oliver

Oliver was born early and survived meningitis twice. Despite cerebral palsy, epilepsy, and autism, he became a talented athlete and was loved by all.



What Went Wrong?

In 2016, Oliver was treated with anti-psychotic medication for seizure-related agitation. He got worse and died from a rare side effect called Neuroleptic Malignant Syndrome.



What Could Have Helped?

Oliver's story could have been different if healthcare staff had followed:

Ask – Listen – Do

ASK families and patients what they need and what worries them.

LISTEN carefully and respect their experience.

DO something – work together and take action.

Oliver's McGowan Mandatory Training



The Oliver McGowan Mandatory Training on Learning Disability and Autism was established following the untimely death of Oliver McGowan in 2016. In response, Oliver's family have organised training that is co-designed with experts, people with lived experience, and professionals.

It was introduced to address the widespread lack of knowledge and to ensure that health, social care, and education professionals have the skills to provide equitable and compassionate care.

The training is aimed at anyone working in health and social care settings, from frontline staff to leadership roles.
